
Also, sponsoring education of the poor and needy children provides them a platform for better education. It is being planned to sponsor 2 students with poor background for GNM nursing course. Once the course is completed, it may help them with good employment. This employment will help them with better standard of living, and also may become an example for other Village people that how education can transform the lives of their children. People in Jangal Mahal area are not even aware of importance of education for their children, and are reluctant to send them to Schools. Such examples



may help them change their mind, if the life of any child among them is changed because of education.

Also, poor students will also be sponsored with their education fees. In addition to this, tutor's remuneration, hostel expenses of students and other educational expenses of students like tuitions, mid-day meal, uniform, shoes etc. will also be sponsored which will encourage and help them to continue their study. This will help the poor students with better Schooling, which may lay the foundation for their better future.
